With the UK still in the midst of a Cost-of-Living crisis, we would like to remind our families that it's worth checking if you may be entitled to free school meals for your child.

Certain criteria must be met in order to be eligible. Please see the information below from Thurrock Council.

(If you are already in receipt of free school meals, please disregard this message)

Υ	our child must be attending a maintained school in the Thurrock area. If your child is attending school outside o
Т	hurrock, you must apply to the council for the area in which they attend school.
Α	All applications will be checked. We may ask you to provide evidence. You must supply the information
r	equested within 2 weeks so we can process your application.

Even if your child brings a packed lunch to school every day or already receives a free school lunch under the Universal Infant Free School Meals initiative, the school will receive additional funding from the Department for Education for every child eligible for free school meals. This means that we have the opportunity to purchase the very best equipment and resources for your child to access at school.
